Conditions and terms of enrolment

- I have read, understand and agree to abide by the conditions stated in the latest edition of the Parent Handbook
- **I agree to pay all Before and After School Care fees before my Vacation Care bookings will be accepted**
- I agree that 48 hours' (2 working days) notice of non-attendance must be given otherwise I will be charged for the booked sessions
- **I agree that 7 days notice will be given for cancellation for excursion days**
- I understand that fees are due and payable a minimum of one week in advance at all times, and I may be required to enter into a payment plan using PCYC's prescribed third party company, if my fees are not paid or if my account is in arrears.
- I will ensure my child/ren arrives at the service with closed in shoes, a water bottle, a hat and sun smart clothing. I understand that if my child does not come with these items I may be contacted and asked to bring these to the Service or my child may be restricted in their outside play opportunities
- I will advise the Coordinator in writing if someone other than myself will be collecting my child/ren.
- I have familiarised myself with the Behaviour Guidance expectations of the service and have communicated these to my child/ren
- Prior to this Vacation Care I have provided the Nominated Supervisor/Responsible person with an up-to-date copy of my child's medical management plan and associated medication permission form and have participated in the review of my child's risk minimisation plan and communications plan.

PCYC SCHOOL AGE CARE INFORMATION

- The program operates from 6:30am to 6.00pm Monday – Friday. Children are unable to attend the Service outside of these hours. If you will be late to pick up your child/ren please contact the Service immediately. A late fee of \$10.00 for the first 10 minutes and \$1 for every minute after may apply.
- **Payment must be made prior to the commencement of care and continue in line with the PCYC Policy. Failure for payment may result in cancellation of care.**
- To receive your CCB/CCR rebate you must submit the correct CRN and DOB for the child/ren and family. Full fees will be charged when incorrect information is provided. Unfortunately due to CCMS and time restrictions we will only provide an estimate fee amount upon receiving bookings, account statements will be emailed once bookings have been finalised
- **Bookings should be received by Monday 27th of March or a Higher Rate of \$60 per day will be applied to your account.**
- **LIMITED places available on Excursion days due to Staff/Child ratio**
- Excursions/Incursions: cost extra and are compulsory if booked in on the day. The costs are added to your fees
- Children must be at the service by 8.30am on excursion days not children will be taken after this time.
- Casual bookings shall only be available to families where the Service has places available 24 hours notice is required and a late booking fee will be applied to your account.
- Food and Drinks: PCYC has a food and nutrition policy which promotes healthy eating practices. Parents will need to provide a healthy morning tea, afternoon tea and lunch. We ask that parents provide healthy alternatives for children if providing your own food or notify staff well in advanced if there are any special dietary requirements. Children are required to bring a water bottle each day; water facilities are available for refills.
- Dress: PCYC have a sun safe policy and as such children need to bring a hat each day and wear appropriate sun smart clothing and protective clothing (no tank, tube or singlet tops). Closed in shoes are required to be worn every day. If your child does not come with these items you may be contacted and asked to bring these back to the Service or your child may be restricted in their outdoor play opportunities.
- PCYC acknowledges that children will bring to the Service or carry with them certain items of personal belongings. All items brought to the Service shall be done solely at the discretion and responsibility of the parent/carers and child. No responsibility will be taken by the Service for any items brought to the Service which may become lost, stolen or damaged.
- Parent hand books and further information is available on the parent table. If you cannot find what you are looking for please see one of our friendly educators.
