The review team would like to hear from our school community and I encourage anyone who is interested to have their say. Your feedback is important and will help us continue to deliver a quality education for students.

PROGRAM

- 9.9.15am to 9.30am** **All other classes to be at the oval promptly prior to 9.30am.**
- Prepare students for the run - make sure they have a hat, sunscreen, sensible running shoes, water bottle and medication (asthma puffers) if necessary.
- 9.30am** First event begins.
- Event 1** 12 year old –boys/girls (born 2004) – 6 laps of the full course.
- Event 2** 11 year old –boys/girls (born 2005) – 6 laps of the full course.
- Event 3** 10 year old –boys/girls (born 2006) – 4 laps of the full course.
- Event 4** Year 4 Girls / Boys – (those born 2007) 2 laps of the full course.
- Event 5** Year 3 Girls / Boys – 2 laps of the full course
- Event 6** Year 2 Girls / Boys – 2 laps of oval course (not around admin building)
- Event 7** Year 1 Girls / Boys – 2 laps of oval course (not around admin building)
- Event 8** Prep Girls / Boys – 2 laps of oval course (not around admin building)

Presentation of ribbons will immediately follow the completion of each race. 1st = Blue ribbon, 2nd = Red ribbon and 3rd = Green ribbon.

Participation ribbon will also be awarded to students in Years Prep – 2.

Presentations to the Winning House will be completed after all of the races.
