This funding will be used to

- Maintain 100% of Year 3 and Year 5 students achieving the National Minimum Standard in Reading in NAPLAN.
- Increase the percentage of students in the Upper Two Bands in Reading (NAPLAN) to 50% in Year 3 and Year 5.
- Increase the percentage of students achieving U2B Regional Benchmarks for Reading to 50% (Fountas & Pinnell):
 - Prep – Level G
 - Year 1 – Level K
 - Year 2 – Level Q
 - Year 3 – Level S

Our initiatives include

- Continued refinement of a whole school approach to teaching reading, across all areas of the curriculum.
- Improving teacher pedagogy through coaching, mentoring, collaborative feedback and professional development.
- An ongoing cycle of data collection, analysis and monitoring of student performance to inform teaching.

Purchasing extra teacher aide hours as part of a whole school explicit instruction reading program.	\$18,386
Purchasing a TRS teacher for release time for classroom teachers to complete reading testing, analyse data and participate in data meetings.	\$14,773
Purchasing extra teacher aide hours for literacy intervention	\$14,526
