### Curriculum

Students have settled really well into their learning in their new classes. All teachers have sent out a curriculum overview which will give you some information on the different learning areas.

### Pre-service teachers

Currently we have four pre-service teachers, Miss Murray, Miss Santa Cruz, Miss Macdonald and Mr Stevens in the school. They are doing lesson observations, small group teaching and some whole class teaching over their 3 weeks.

### Before school and after school

A reminder that children should not be at school before 8:30am unless they are enrolled in before school care. Playground duty starts at 8:30am and 'Fruit Bat' at 8:45am and classes

start at 9:00am. The school day ends at 3:00pm and all students must be actively supervised after school.

Please avoid filming or taking photos of children before or after school in the playground. We have a number of families who have requested that images of their children are not used by the school. Staff will ask you to stop filming or taking photos if there are other children in the area.

### Year 5 & 6 Camp

Our annual camp will be held in Week 4, Monday 15<sup>th</sup> February to Friday 19<sup>th</sup> February. We are going to Currumbin Valley for our camp this year. Mrs Glowrey will be teacher in charge while I am away.

### Facilities Update

Work on the new building is going ahead on schedule. Originally the building was to have 5 classrooms, and half of the ground floor was going to be an undercover area. Due to our continued and forecast growth, the Department has agreed to build the extra 2 classrooms in underneath as part of this build. This is great news for the school moving forward!
